DISTANCES

Most of you are flying into Busselton airport which is a 30 min drive to Bunker Bay. Those of you coming into Perth airports will have a 3 hour drive.

On your way to Bunker Bay you'll pass through Dunsborough, our closest town, where you will find everything you might need for your stay - it's a 10 minute drive from Bunker Bay.

TRANSPORT

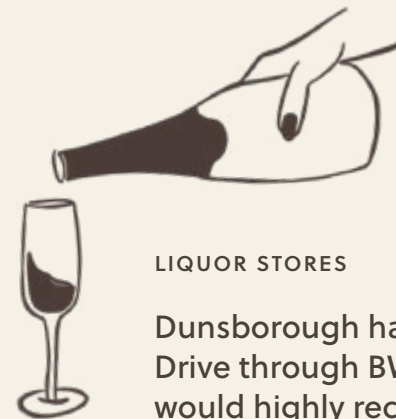


I really recommend hiring a car. There is so much for you to explore in the Margaret River region.

For those of you without a car, you'll need to pre-book your Uber or taxi for airport pick up and drop off. It costs around \$100 from Busselton airport to Bunkers, and \$500 from the Perth International airport.

PRE-ARRIVAL GROCERIES

Coles and Woolworths offer groceries and alcohol deliveries to The Pullman Resort or any of the Private Property rentals. For deliveries you will need to enter the suburb **Naturaliste** and the post code is 6281. The Pullman Resort address is 42 Bunker Bay Road, Naturaliste.



LIQUOR STORES

Dunsborough has a Liquorland next to Coles and a Drive through BWS at the Dunsborough pub, but I would highly recommend using Dunsborough Cellars for all your alcohol needs. It has an incredible range of local and imported wines, a great range of beers, plus all your favourite spirits and they will match the Liquorland prices.
